### Lent Witnessing

Witnessing for our faith can be downright terrifying! As we prepare to contemplate His death and celebrate His resurrection during this Holy Lenten season here are some ideas from the website Intentional Living, a Ministry of Family Life Radio, to be better Evangelizers.

Here are 10 "One Thing" ideas you can do to be a better "Evangelist" in this Lenten Season. Pick one, do it and wait for a miracle!

1. Today, ask God to show you one person that needs encouragement and a personal relationship with Christ, then ask that person for permission to pray for and (if appropriate) pray with them.
2. Commit today that you will be on the lookout for opportunities to share your faith.
3. Today, try saying "God bless you" to someone you might not normally interact with – and then pray that you have another opportunity to say more to that person in the future.
4. Pick up an inexpensive Bible today and give it to a friend or neighbor who's going through a difficult time.
5. Today, ask someone you know who doesn't go to church to come along with you for Easter Sunday Mass and breakfast or lunch afterwards.
6. Ask God to help you today to be a "living testimony" for Him in your workplace.
7. Sign up to volunteer at a soup kitchen, rescue or homeless mission or crisis pregnancy center, where you can be "intentional" about helping others and sharing your faith.
8. Go to [www.needhim.org](http://www.needhim.org) today and read up on how to actually verbalize your faith to others.
9. If you have a website, a Facebook page, or tweet your status updates via Twitter....use that space to share what God is doing in your life.
10. Finally, make certain that however you choose to witness to others, that it matches up with how you actually and really do live your faith life.
