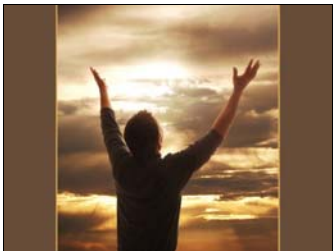

What is the *Living in Christ* Retreat?
